Sustainable Garden Latest



The Campus Sustainable Garden area is progressing with the recent addition of a surrounding fence. All three

schools are involved in sustainability initiatives across Campus via the Sustainability Committee and as the garden continues to develop, you will see new activities inside the fence to promote recycling, sustainability and the growth of the veggies. A new compost bin will be built soon through the Campus partnership with Ucount and the guys from the Men's Shed.



Recycling the Campus Way

As part of the recycling program (and to assist in Campus fundraising) we are initiating a scheme to reclaim used aluminium cans and plastic bottles which carry the 10c deposit logo. Families will be issued with a calico Campus bag. Simply hang it on a door handle at home and place used cans and plastic bottles in it. Once filled, return it to your classroom to be emptied into the recycling bin in class.



These will then be taken to the Sustainability area sub-depot and eventually taken to the depot to reclaim the deposits. Money from

this scheme will assist in Campus-wide initiatives. So don't throw them in your bin at home, bring them to school and help raise money for the Campus. *Please make sure all cans and bottles are completely empty.*

Campus Kids Play Cafe

The Play Cafe is open every Tuesday and Friday during the school term, from 9.30am to 1.30pm in the Geoff Simpson Hall. Campus Sensory Garden Walk

Late last year Campus was successful in attracting a small grant to establish a Sensory Garden from the Million Trees "Grow a Great School" initiative. Located between the PAC and Nativity School, the garden will be planted with heritage pre-settlement flowering shrubs, creepers and grasses, which were all native to Aberfoyle Park over 150 years ago.



The garden will feature a pathway allowing students to wander through and smell, feel, see and learn about the variety of flora which was here before the area was settled. Plants for this project are being grown from seeds and will be ready for students to plant out in the middle of the year.
