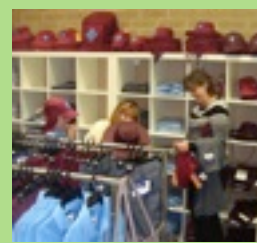
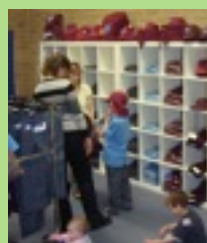
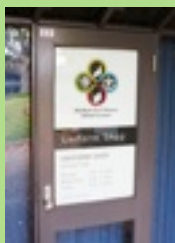


Campus Music Night

Kids Hope

A new mentoring program known as “Kids Hope” has commenced at Campus. Through our partnership with



Ucount Support Services, this World Vision program has begun in Term 2 with Thiele chosen as the initial school, but with plans to incorporate it into Pilgrim and Nativity in the future. “Kids Hope” utilises community volunteers providing mentors to selected students each week for one hour throughout the year. So far there are 14 mentors seeing 14 students for cooking, art, sport and other student-requested activities.

The program monitors the student’s progress and helps to assist learning in the classroom. Already there have been positive outcomes and Thiele Deputy Principal, Sharon Willoughby acknowledges that “we are privileged to have their support & commitment and we appreciate their time and valuable contribution to our school and students”.
