Local Anzacs Honoured



Very late in 2014, Campus was successful in attracting a grant from the Centenary of Anzac Local Community Grants Program. The \$8310 Australian Government grant will allow Campus to build an Anzac memorial on the site of the former dental clinic, in front of the Campus Office. Dedicated to the 97 men & women from this local area who served in WW1, the memorial will be used for commemorative services for Anzac Day, Remembrance Day and other school or community services.

Work will commence shortly to install the granite memorial, surrounding paving and rosemary hedge. It is hoped that all will be completed in time for the 100th anniversary of Anzac in April this year.
