Campus Anzac Memorial



Thursday 9th April saw the **Anzac Memorial Dedication Ceremony** at Campus. Guests included the Federal Senator for Veteran Affairs, Hon. Michael Ronaldson, Hon. Dr. Andrew Southcott- member for Boothby, Nat Cook- member for Fisher, Mayor Lorraine Rosenberg, Frank Blamey- Blackwood RSL, Fr Charles of Nativity Parish, Rev. Dr. Jonathan Davies of Seeds Uniting, Lyn Such & other VIP guests, service men & women and family members of Campus students. In a simultaneous ceremony at two sites, all Campus students and staff filled the main courtyard to hear speeches from dignitaries and observe a minutes silence. At the memorial site, the monument received an official church blessing and Senator Ronaldson cut the ribbon. Wreaths were laid at both sites as the bugler played the Last Post before the guests returned to the main courtyard to hear the Campus students all sing the "Last Anzac" song, accompanied by the Campus band. Thanks to all who attended, making this a very special Campus event.



Thanks also to Nalty Memorials who created the plinth and plaque & Steve Johns from Tradescape Australia for building the paving, flagpole & landscaping the entire area.



The Campus Memorial was made possible via a grant obtained as part of the Australian Government's Centenary of Anzac Local Grants Program. Each Federal Electorate was allocated an amount to share between selected grant applicants and Campus successfully attracted \$8,310 to erect the monument on the former site of the dental clinic. After a nervous wait, Campus was only notified in January 2015 that we had been successful. As the memorial sits outside the Campus gates, this site can be used by the general community, as well as serving Campus for future commemorations.

The Performing Arts Centre is available at only \$220 per half day (out of school hours) and boasts a stage, 250 seat auditorium, kitchen and full A/V set up if required.



The Geoff Simpson Hall (aka OSHC) is also available to hire at an hourly rate of \$22. It is available on most weekends.



The Campus Gymnasium is another venue suitable for external hires. It is also \$22 per hour and is ideal for a variety of uses, including sporting practices, presentations and classes.
