Performing Arts

Welcome to a new, exciting year of Performing Arts on Campus! All of our students will be involved in a dynamic program of Performing Arts classes this year, and we are very much looking forward to working with your children.

There are also a range of wonderful additional experiences and opportunities outlined below, that we encourage students to get involved in.

Campus Performing Arts groups and ensembles

The following Campus Performing Arts groups/ensembles will be offered to our students this year. Please note that all groups/ensembles started in Week 3, and all meet in the Performing Arts Centre. If your child missed the first session, they are still welcome to attend this week.

The first two sessions of each ensemble are 'come and try' sessions for interested students; after this time, a commitment to remaining with the ensemble/group for the year and attending all performances (if applicable) is expected. The exception is Senior Choir, which all Year 6 students participate in and is optional for Year 7s.

Permission notes will go home to parents in Weeks 3 and 4, to be returned **by the end of Week 5**.

We hosted an Instrumental Assembly on Thursday of Week 1, which gave our students the opportunity to learn about and hear the range of instruments and

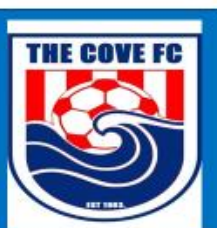
