## Katrina Germein Visit



Katrina Germein is an Adelaide author who has written a number of exceptional picture books.

In Week 8 she visited us on Campus with all Reception to Year 3 students having the opportunity to meet her and learn from her. She encouraged students to see themselves as authors and to write their own stories. She shared how she develops the ideas for her stories and how those stories are

made into books through the work of illustrators and publishers. Her sessions were highly entertaining and informative.

## 3D printing on Campus

Over the course of this term a number of classes have begun working with Makers Empire to design various objects that they have then printed on the 3D printer.



Projects have included: design your own insect; design a nesting box for native birds, microbats or possums; design a fidget toy for a student with autism; design your own playground equipment; design and create a character that represents a part of the brain and its function.



One of the challenges with 3D printing is sustainability. During printing, there is waste from rafts, supports and failed prints. To address this we are working with Daniel a young engineering student who has begun his own company, taking our PLA plastic waste and turning it back into usable filament.



We have also been working with students to consider if their product is ready to print, where that item will be in 5 years' time, if

all parts are connected and big enough or small enough to print.



# Campus Disco

A wonderful evening was had by all that attended the 2018 Campus Disco. We had approximately 350 children attend the two sessions.



A big thank you to Richard Rowland who was our DJ and did a marvelous job getting all of the children involved. In addition, we would not have been able to have such a successful evening without the help of all of our wonderful parent volunteers. An estimated total of \$2500 was raised for the Campus Pedal Prix Team.



# FYI Programs on Campus

During Week 7, 9 and 10 all classes across Campus have taken part in a FYI session. **FYI Education** is a South Australian business which is using new and exciting interactive technology to engage and inspire children to learn.

Classes enter a "Top Secret" Inflatable classroom that appears in their school and they are transported to a place where they can become "Junior Secret Agents".



Their mission is to work through the Spy Mission chosen for them by their teachers. Each mission is age and year level appropriate and the topics within them are specific to the ACARA Health and PE Curriculum document.
